Giant's Causeway: Visual Story

Walk does not include the Giant's Causeway Stones.



Welcome to our relaxed and friendly walk along the coast. You can take part in any way that feels comfortable for you. There is no right or wrong way to join the walk.



The walk will go ahead in light rain.
If the weather is unsafe, we will contact you, and cancel the walk.

The route includes the following surfaces: tarmac, and some loose chippings.



When: Monday 25th May, from 7.00-8.30pm.

Length of walk: 2km.

Where: The walk takes place at the National Trust, Giant's Causeway, near Bushmills. We will use the **Causeway Coast Way Car Park**.

What to bring

- Comfortable shoes
- Warm, waterproof clothes.

Optional Items:

- Water, Umbrella, Headphones, Ear Defenders, Comfort Item.

Arriving by car:

Walk Leaders will be in the car park from 6.30pm to welcome you.

Parking is free for this walk.

There may be sounds from cars, and people talking.





Meeting staff: Walk Leaders will be wearing high-visibility jackets.

They are **friendly** and there to help you feel **safe** and **comfortable**.

Your **Walk Leaders** will include:

Grace, Rhonda, and Patrick.

It will be OK to take breaks during the walk, walk slowly, or leave early.

You can ask for help at any time.



Toilets are available at the Causeway Coast Way Car Park.

- There is one accessible toilet.
- The rest have standard cubicles.
- They may be a little noisy or echo.
- There are no toilet facilities along the route.



Registering for the walk: After you park, the Walk Leaders will ask you to register.

- There will be a short form to fill in.
- You may need to wait a few minutes if it is busy.
- Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult.
- **The walk is free of charge.**

Photos: We will take photos during the walk.

- You can choose if you are happy to be in photos.
- You will only be included if you give permission.
- Photos will be used on social media and newsletters.



Starting the walk: At 7pm Walk Leader Grace will let everyone know that the walk is starting.

We will start the walk at the picnic benches in the car park.



During the walk: You do not have to talk to anyone if you do not want to. You can walk quietly and at your own pace.



We will walk along the tarmac path towards the Giant's Causeway Visitor Centre.

The path has some small slopes in places but will become more even as we get closer to the Visitor Centre.



When we pass the Giant's Causeway Visitor Centre we will walk along the **Green Trail**, on a tarmac path..



The Green Trail does not go to the Causeway Stones, but we will see them clearly from this path.

You can find more details about the [Green Trail here](#). We will not be going the whole way along it. We will turn back at Port Coon.



What we might see and hear:

- We will hear waves, wind, birds, and people talking.
- We will see the sea, fields, cliffs and perhaps some cows in the distance.
- If it is breezy, the wind and sea be will be noisy.
- Sometimes people see dolphins swimming, but this does not happen every time.



Walking your way: You can walk at your own pace. The group may spread out along the path. There will be a Walk Leader at the front of the group and another at the back. There will always be a Walk Leader nearby.



Taking a break: If you feel tired, you can take a break. Please tell a Walk Leader. You can also turn back early with support. There are benches along the way.



Finishing the walk: The walk will finish back at the car park. A Walk Leader will let you know when the walk has ended.



Refreshments: At the end of the walk there will be light refreshments served at the picnic benches in the Causeway Coast Way Car Park. You can have some if you would like to. You can also leave at any time.
